**Details:** This position will assist adults with dual diagnosis, mental health, complex behaviors, high risk issues and substance abuse. The adults require support to foster community relationships, daily living skills, decision making using a best practice approach to help people to transition to a greater degree of independence and healthy lifestyle choices.

**Hours:** The hours for this position will vary and can include weekends, evenings, and overnights depending on the needs of the program.
